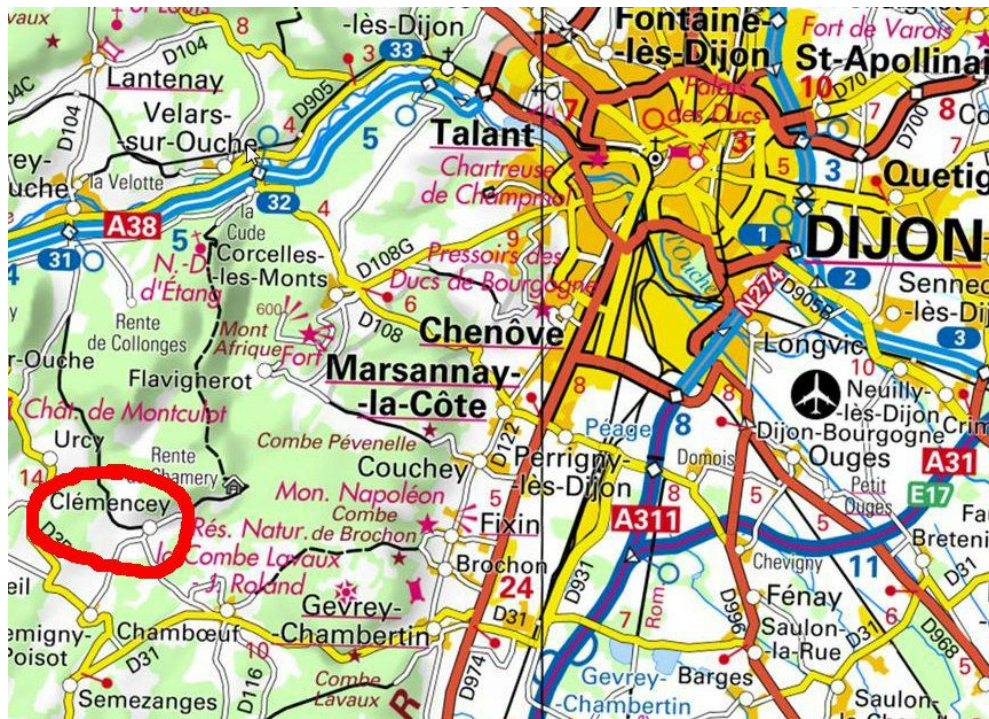
To all participants and spectators we wish a nice spring sunshine will bright and light this outstanding event.

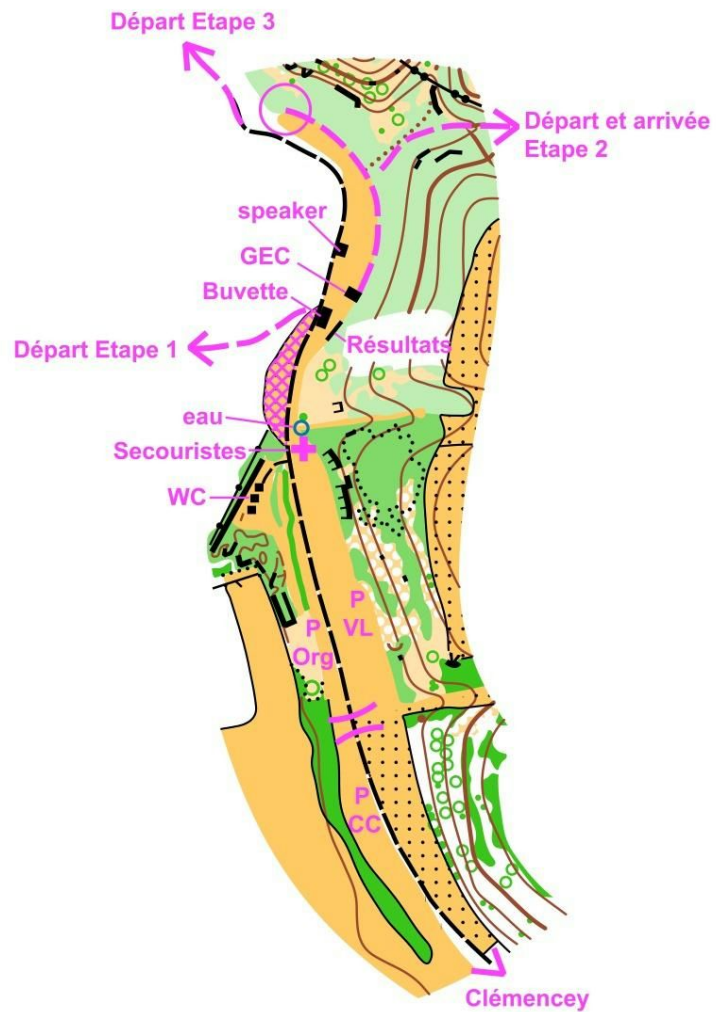
